

Facilities AGM Report

The big jobs this year have been sorting out issues with the water service, upgrades to the data network, cameras, and a few small construction jobs. Here is a little more detail:

- 1) The water line into the lodge froze and the pump motor burned out pretty much right after the World Para Nordic event. We purchased a new pump and installed a temporary above-ground water line which kept the water flowing until the frost came out of the ground. The trouble sections were found and repaired, and the pipe was buried deeper so as to prevent recurrence. Several side issues with filters, valves, toilets, the fountain, and basically every part of the water system came along due to the heavy turbidity resulting from the disturbance to the well.
- 2) During the WPNSC our network was overwhelmed with address requests and caused a little anxiety (although no real trouble). To address this I have begun a series of upgrades including a cabinet rebuild, some new switching equipment, expansion of the wireless infrastructure, and will soon be adding more high-speed switching and a more capable router that will support more users, and better security.
- 3) This summer's changes include posts between the parking lot and the stadium, finishing on the dormer on the steel shop, a fence to tidy up appearances between the shop and the ski trail just past parking lot #2, and there are new benches under construction for the wax room. Also, an additional shipping container is being set up on the far side of the biathlon range. Once moved into place it will provide stadium-level storage for fencing which needs a home between competitions.
