### **Discussion Items:**

1. *Review & approval of Agenda*

## General Managers report

- Membership ~2040, expect another membership drive when snow arrives.
- Paid vs unpaid staff: All staff is paid hourly, except for General Manager. Staff currently preparing for ski season – part time. Full time currently only GM and two head coaches. Lisa and Nicole part time or depending on workload, budgeted for approximately 30 hours per week but expect to fluctuate over winter.
- Website – Old website & updated Nordic Pulse website don't meet club's needs. Exploring alternative provider with more up-to-date software to allow easier updates from staff. Website update is an identified priority for staff and Board.

## Director of Facilities report

- Progress has been made on making the Kopar cabins wheelchair accessible. Ramps to be installed week of Dec 4.

## Competitions report

- 2024 Para Biathlon World Championships & 2024 Para Nordic World Cup Finals
  - Ongoing engagement with International Ski and Snowboard Federation (FIS), keen to assist with marketing, promotion, venue dressing, other
  - Medals & clothing under production
  - Budget – surplus position with contingencies
  - Live streaming still under negotiation
  - Volunteer registration live <https://zone4.ca/register.asp?id=33869>
  - Grant applications pending for \$265,000 from many sponsors (unsuccessful with PG Community Foundation for \$10,000; successful with Pomeroy for \$25,000)
- Competitions Committee:
  - \$6,500 grants received
  - Several websites and registration sites live for upcoming events
  - Not much interest for March Loppet
- Snowmaking
  - Pumps working and systems upgraded – all ready for appropriate weather conditions
- Paved competition trails - Destination Development Fund
  - Canfor committed to support (drone flight of area to help with planning, use of RoadEng software for detailed design)

## President's report

- Learning about paved trail project and definition of major undertaking. Options if Board decides member referendum required
- Learning about land acquisition initiative (License of Occupation). Communication with Cranbrook Hill Greenway Society and Miworth Community Association
- Work with Monica on member engagement

## Trails report

- Grooming team & machinery ready; snowmaking ready
- New 2023 Skidoo Skandic 900 in fleet for this season
- 2016 Skandic 900 not functioning. Fort St James' club mechanic looking to see if serviceable with potential future interest in purchase.
- Disc golf baskets pulled and in storage

### 2. *Update from Competitions Program – Guest Head Coach Ali Cadell*

- Overview of program (9-18 year olds, future goal of including university program, 46 athletes currently)
- Job share with Tuppy Hoehn
- Goal to keep racing program as healthy as possible and to connect XC and biathlon programs. Skills Development Program (SDP) numbers are low so concerned about future recruitment. Also wish for more contact with Board.
- Role: Organize all programs including coaching, applying for grants, working with sports organizations, etc. Rely on local coaches when travelling, don't have as many as are needed but common problem across clubs in Canada. Write weekly training plans for >14 year olds including nutrition, sleeping, etc.
- Provide race support. Sometimes budget goes over because accommodation costs increasing
- Fundraising goal of \$20,000 for this year
- April = rest month but run program spring, summer, fall.
- Very excited for paved trail project. Increases athlete safety. Roller skiing extends training season.

### 3. *Approval of minutes*

### 4. *Discussion of Safe Sport - Cross Country BC Harassment, Discipline & Complaints Policy*

- Policy protects coaches and volunteers as well as athletes and participants
- Will be posted for all to see (see action items)
- Process underway to ensure efficiency for coaches' criminal records checks

### 5. *Discussion of Bylaw Committee*

- Invitation for interested member closes Dec 5
- Scope of work and role of committee to be determined through terms of reference drafting (Tim – see action items) and Board approval, including process
  - Potential that committee members provide expression of interest and ideas for bylaw changes

- o Terms of reference clarify scope and role of committee, recommendations to Board
- o Clarify committee process. I.e., compare bylaws of existing clubs or start from ground up.

#### 6. *Update on Partnership Agreement with Lheidli T'enneh*

- Meeting with Kevin Brown, public relations director on Dec 4 with Lance Past President and John GM
- Lheidli is excited about this partnership (only three partnerships – PG airport, Chamber of Commerce, CNSC)
- Family Day – Feb 19 is potential day to incorporate Lheidli T'enneh into club. Lheidli are interested in being part of existing initiatives - looking for ideas on what the day could include (youth program, drumming, elders at fire pit)
- Partnership agreements commits to annual review between Council and Board, therefore review needed before next summer
- Potential to use club as land-based learning facility with School District 57 but budget not available at this time. Grants required.
- CNSC is exclusively on Lheidli traditional territory. Trapline was in the area. Second largest Lheidli village just across the river from CNSC
- Can use materials, information, signage from airport at CNSC

#### 7. *Discussion of paved trails project*

- Discussion around major undertaking, past Board decisions, interests in the project and processes to arrive at current state
- Scope of referendum – bylaws say major undertaking requires special resolution. Also required when club wants to borrow money.
- Information necessary, should a referendum be recommended – scope, cost of project, future maintenance requirements, potential increase in member dues, model to fund iteratively
- Precedent – no resolution on snow making, biathlon range, lighting, lodge construction
- “Major” may be a relative term; no criteria to define major
- Special Board meeting planned for January (see action items)

#### 8. *Discussion of land acquisition*

- Application submitted and under review to FrontCounter BC
- Expect continued erosion of access on eastern part of CNSC (dog trails on Terasen private property)
- Public review and comment period needs to be shared with membership (see action items)
- Questions and concerns from Miworth Community Association to be addressed
- Meeting to be scheduled with Cranbrook Hill Greenway Society
